Request for Applications PY 2025-2026

The Loss Prevention Grant Fund provides support for innovative efforts to reduce liability exposure through funding of specific education, purchases and research projects.

The core purpose of the Loss Prevention Grant Fund is to improve quality of care and decrease liability. Grants are awarded for a one-year period and may not be used to cover ongoing operational expenses, or to fund permanent

The Loss Prevention Grant Fund will award up to a total of \$125,000 for all grants funded in Policy Year 2025-2026.

Application for this grant is open to all Brown University Health employees and eligible affiliated physicians.

Applications for grants must be received by Loss Prevention no later than **Friday, May 16, 2025**.

The Preliminary Review Committee will review and score all applications. The top-ranking applications will be submitted to the Executive Review Committee for approval and award. Principle investigators/applicants will be notified by email of the final award status.
